



Application Tips

Adding the product to your paint,

Make sure the mix is stirred completely with a drill stirrer, or really well by hand and if necessary, thin with ½ a cup of water per gallon, or follow the thinning recommendations on the paint, splotchy areas come from lack of mixing. Insuladd works properly with 2 coats.

Using a Roller to apply,

Roller tracks are caused by poor roller choice, make sure you use a high quality roller, apply evenly and do not try to put it on thick, just like normal painting you want to use a pattern stroke to ensure no roller tracks. Don't press down hard as the paint won't spread evenly.

Using a Spray Gun to apply,

Remove any filters to ensure the product doesn't get trapped and the product will apply evenly.

Glossy Finish,

If Insuladd is used in the top coat you will need to select a higher gloss, a gloss will be semi-gloss when finished, if used just in the primer then apply top coat without Insuladd then there is no effect on the gloss.
